e-Therapeutics⁺ is Canada's authoritative source for prescribing and managing drug therapy at the point-of-care. It provides access to evidence-based Canadian drug and therapeutic information; best practices information on common medical conditions; and much more. You'll also find a tab for **E-CPS**, the Canadian gateway to online drug information in English & French. It includes Health Canada-approved up-to-date product monographs; direct links to Health Canada alerts; reliable searches by brand, generic and therapeutic class; printable handouts; and fully searchable directories that provide contact information and direct links for poison control centres, health organizations and manufacturers.

STAT!Ref Electronic Resources include 25 of the most current full-text core reference books related to all areas of nursing practice in addition to a variety of point-of-care tools such as MedCalc3000 and Stedman's Medical Dictionary. Stat!Ref also offers **Anatomy TV**, the world's most detailed 3D interactive model of human anatomy online.

EBSCO HOST DATABASES INCLUDE:

- **CINAHL Plus with Full Text** is the world's most comprehensive nursing and allied health research database, providing access to more than 620 full text journals.
- **MEDLINE with Full Text** is the world's most comprehensive source of articles from medical journals, providing full-text articles from more than 1,200 journals.
- **The Cochrane Library** consists of three sections: 1) Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews (full text), 2) Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effectiveness (DARE), and 3) Cochrane [worldwide] Controlled Trials Register.
- **The Canadian Nurses Association Collection** provides full text access to a collection of articles from the Canadian Nurse Journal and Infirmière Canadienne.
- **GreenFILE** is a collection of scholarly, government and general interest titles covering all aspects of human impact on the environment including global warming, green building, pollution, renewable energy, recycling and provides full text for **more than 4,600 records**.
- **Teacher Reference Centre** provides indexing and abstracts for more than **270** of the most popular teacher and administrator **journals and magazines** to assist professional educators.

OTHER INFORMATION

My iLibrary offers nurses access to an additional **374 electronic textbooks** in nursing and health care.

The Conference Board of Canada e-Library provides insights on economic trends, public policy and organizational performance, information of interest to nurses in professional development and public policy.

Created by the CNA, **The Patient Safety Resource Guide** is a fully searchable database containing references related to all aspects of patient safety.

In addition, NurseONE provides nurses with access to **Webliographies** that are created monthly based on a "hot topic", and **Essential Reads** is a collection of grey literature reports on nursing issues with national and international perspectives.
